Scope and Content Notes

The Fullerton Assembly Collection contains two oral histories: Ron Womack, a current Placentia, California member, and Pam Minor, a past member. Additionally, the collection contains the following: photographs (16), books (27), publications of *The Torch and Testimony* (volumes 1 - 30), and folders (4) containing ephemera.

Fullerton Assembly Background

The Fullerton Assembly, a Christian-based religious organization, was started in 1970 by George and Betty Geftakys in Fullerton, California. At this time in United States history there was a great spiritual enthusiasm from the Jesus movement and it is in this setting that the Fullerton Assembly was established. The Assembly grew in membership as well as geographically, having a presence in twelve states and twenty-two countries. It began with seminars hosted by the Geftakys in their home and grew to meetings held in other Southern California and US cities. This spread of the Assembly was accomplished through the work of appointed Brothers and Sisters. Meetings at the various locations would typically be held at the houses of those appointed. For purposes of reaching the young, many Assemblies were located near college campuses.

Under the Geftaky's leadership, the Assembly continued for three decades until 2003, when George Geftakys was excommunicated from the Assembly for "his failure to deal with his son's domestic violence, and for his own immoral relationships with women in the Assemblies over the years".¹ After Geftakys was forced to leave the Assembly, the organization contracted in terms of membership and locations. As of 2008, splinter Assembly organizations exist.
