# Alumni Outcomes Report :


# California State University, Fullerton

This report details the employment outcomes of 20,032 alumni who graduated from all programs and levels (i.e., Bachelor, Master, and Doctorate) at CSUF between 2010 and 2020, based on matching institution's student data to Emsi's database of online profiles. To count as a matched record, a profile has to match the institution's past student information on the name and at least one of the following: contact information or award information (such as graduation year, program name, etc.). Unmatched alumni are not included in this report.

### **Executive Summary**

Emsi found 20,032 matched profiles using student data provided by CSUF. Among these matched profiles, 73% of alumni are employed in the field, and 79% are currently residing in the region (i.e., Los Angeles County, Orange County, Riverside County, and San Bernardino County).

## **Earnings**

Based on their occupations and where alumni live, the estimation of what alumni could be making at their current ages is \$57,800/year, and the potential wage based on the average wage for their occupations is \$91,100/year.

**Estimated wage**: the average of the estimated wage for each of your selected alumni, based on the median wage for their occupation in their county, adjusted for age and degree level.


**Potential wage**: The average potential wage for each of your selected alumni, based on the average wage for their occupation in their county.

# What jobs are alumni getting?

Figure 2 displays the education-to-career paths of your alumni based on their program of study and current occupation. Overall, the majority of alumni (73%) is currently working in the field.

Note: This diagram includes up to the top 25 occupations with all remaining occupations grouped under All Other Occupations.

Tables 1 and 2 display the employment outcomes of alumni based on their current role. Standardized occupation codes and job titles classify these outcomes. The most common occupation is Accountants and Auditors, represented by 4% of alumni. The most common job title of alumni Accountants and Auditors (4%).

## Who do alumni work for?

Table 3 shows the top companies employing CSUF alumni. Excluding California State University, Fullerton, the majority of alumni who graduated from the university are employed by University of California (1%).

# What skills do alumni possess?

Figure 3 and Table 4 show the top skills alumni from the program have included in their online profiles. "Customer Service" is the most frequently stated skill (53%). Other frequently listed skills include "Microsoft Office", "Microsoft Excel," and "Microsoft Word."

Figure 3. Top Skills Listed in Alumni's Profiles



#### Where do alumni live?

Tables 5 and 6, along with the map below display the top locations of your alumni. The larger the bubble, the more alumni reside in that location. The largest portion of alumni lives in Orange, CA (20%).





### When did alumni graduate?

Figure 4 shows the number of alumni who completed their program of study in the corresponding graduation year. The majority of the alumni with matched profiles between 2006 and 2020 graduated in 2012.

#### Education
