Will it serve society/community?</li> <li>• Are the methods clearly and specifically described? (Can you tell what the applicant will do? Is the description concrete?)</li> <li>• Does the applicant address resources? IRB (if warranted)?</li> <li>• Does the proposed project advance the proposers scholarly and/or creative agenda?</li> <li>• Do the proposer’s qualifications fit with this app?</li> <li>• Does the CV include relevant prior scholarly and/or creative work, awarded grant roles, titles &amp; values?</li> </ul>	/15
<p><b><u>Expected Outcomes/Means of Dissemination</u></b>  <b>400 words</b>  <b>10 points</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Are the outcomes adequately described?</li> <li>• How specifically is the dissemination plan described?</li> <li>• Are the project milestones adequately discussed? Is the timeline feasible? Does it include potential rehearsal, draft, presentation, or submission dates?</li> <li>• How do the outcomes fit with the University Strategic Plan?</li> </ul>	/10
<p><b><u>Budget Justification</u></b>  <b>300 words</b>  <b>5 points</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How specific, justified, and comprehensive is the narrative description of the budget?</li> <li>• Is the narrative aligned with the “budget template”?</li> <li>• Does the proposer describe any other assigned time, if applicable?</li> </ul>	/5
<p><b><u>Past Intramural Awards</u></b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has the proposer ever received an intramural grant?</li> </ul>
