- 1. Have completed one or more semesters of college course work at CSUF, with a declared major or minor in Health Education, Health Science, or Public Health.
  - **Exception:** Incoming transfer students considered only if they have a declared major or minor in Health Education, Health Science, or Public Health.
- 2. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 grade point scale); or if cumulative GPA is between 2.75 and 2.99, have earned a GPA of at least 3.0 in the previous two full term (Fall or Spring) semesters
- 3. Submit the following four (4) items to the KHS office (KHS 121) by <u>**Tuesday, October 8th**</u> to participate in the 2020 Spring Induction Ceremony:
  - **This completed application for membership.**
  - A copy of **unofficial transcripts** (not the Titan Degree Audit), available through your Student Portal.
  - □ Wallet size or 5x7 picture of self, for ceremonial purposes
  - Payment (by check only) of \$85: National Initiation Fee (\$50), and local chapter membership fee (\$35: \$25 to ceremonies & \$10 to events). Make check payable to ESG, Delta Rho Chapter
