

AMERICAN STUDIES OUTSTANDING REENTRY STUDENT AWARD APPLICATION

The American Studies Outstanding Reentry Student Award is given out once each year in the late spring. This \$500 award, funded by a former graduate who wishes to remain anonymous, is designed to recognize and reward the accomplishments of an American Studies graduating senior who returned to school after a substantial break in his or her education. It is open to students who graduated from high school and then took several years off (for any reason) before starting college, or to students who began their college careers (either at CSUF, a community college, or anywhere else) and then took several years off before returning to complete their B.A. degree.

If you are a graduating senior who meets these criteria, please fill out the information below and attach a letter that describes your personal educational history. Your letter should explain when and why you took a substantial break either before you began college or while you were attending college, why you decided to complete your education, and why you developed an interest in pursuing your degree in American Studies.
