Denmark

Denmark consistently ranks among the happiest countries in the world. This four-week program considers the secrets behind Danes' contentment with special emphases on food and diversity. Together we will learn about Denmark's rich culture and history, as well as the country's response to rising diversity within its borders. We will explore the beautiful city of Copenhagen—its neighborhoods, museums, castles, and restaurants. Activities will include a tour of the diverse Nørrebro neighborhood; a guided visit to Torvehallerne food market; dinner at a "New Nordic" restaurant; and dinner at home with a Danish family. Students will have the chance to give back through service at a food-sharing non-profit and a camp for low-income children.

Program Fees Estimated

The fee per person is \$2167.86. Final program fee is determined by the number of students enrolled in the program.

Non-refundable \$500 deposit due by **March 4, 2019**

Remaining balance \$2300 - \$2800 due by **April 5, 2019**

GEOG 355: Danish Foodways and Sustainability (3 units) [GE D.5]

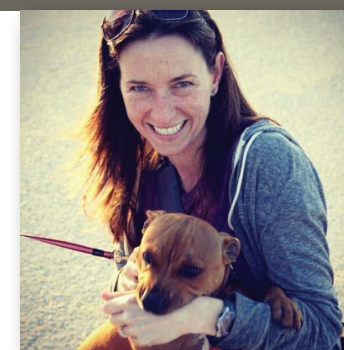
Explore Danish culinary traditions and consider debates over food and multiculturalism, industrial and organic foods, and "zero waste" programs.
