- ▶ Updated EC members on a meeting held with Elaine Estrada (Scheduling office), AVPAP Nwosu, and Ed Sullivan to follow-up regarding revisions to UPS 300.005 Final Examinations and the assurance that the IT system can fully support the document implementation. This policy has been forwarded from Academic Standards Committee for the A.S. agenda 5-15-14. The only change in the document relates to a take-home final or a synchronous online examination. The only way this will work is for all finals to be scheduled by the university.

FT Unit 3 faculty elected to the Academic Senate will use clickers at the 5-15-14 marathon meeting to elect a FT Unit faculty member from the pool of candidates.
