Resolution Allowing Continued Virtual Instruction without Approval

Whereas: The COVID-19 Pandemic has impacted the way in which we do instruction; and

Whereas: For public health and safety, we have transitioned to virtual (online) instruction; and

Whereas: UPS 411.104 (Policy on Online Instruction) requires approval of all courses to be offered

in an online format; and

Whereas: The duration that we will continue virtual instruction is unknown at this time; therefore,

be it

Resolved: That courses may be offered in an online modality (virtual) through the end of the 2020 summer session without the normal approval process required by UPS 411.104; and be it further

Resolved: That should the COVID-19 public health emergency continue into the fall semester of 2020, Senate Executive Committee is empowered to extend this resolution to the end of the fall 2020; and be it finally

Resolved: That copies of this resolution be sent to the CSUF President, Provost, Vice-President for Academic Programs, and all CSUF Deans.
