Resolution on Changes and Exception for GE as a Result of the Implementation of AB1460

Whereas, one option before the CSUF Academic Senate proposes revisions to UPS 411.202 that will increase the number of units required to more than 120 which is prohibited; and

WHEREAS, for some degree programs at CSUF this addition of three units will increase the number of units required to more than 120 which is prohibited; therefore, be it:

RESOLVED, that the CSUF Academic Senate temporarily waives the process for exceptions set forth in UPS 411.202 for majors that are currently 69 units or higher for major requirements or the degree (major and GE) unit total is currently 118 units or higher, and

RESOLVED, that the CSUF Academic Senate waives three units of lower division Area C for majors that are currently 69 units or higher for major requirements or the degree (major and GE) unit total is currently 118 units or higher, and

RESOLVED, that students with this waiver must complete one course each in Area C1 and C2, and

RESOLVED, that Departments may opt out of this waiver by sending a memo, signed by the Dean of their college, to Academic Programs, and

RESOLVED, that departments with 68 or fewer units of major and concentration requirements may petition for a 3-unit waiver using the normal process set forth in UPS 411.202.
