## Resolution in Support of On-line/Hybrid Course Offerings for 2022/2023 Academic Year

- Whereas: The ongoing pandemic demands increased flexibility in course offerings that online and hybrid instruction provide; therefore, be it
- Resolved: CSUF Academic Senate recommend that departments be allowed to offer currently approved classes for in-person modality in Hybrid or Online Modality as defined in UPS 411.104 using special courses tag up to four sections for 2022/2023 academic year; and be it further
- Resolved: That the Academic Senate encourage colleges and departments to continue taking an intentional look at their curriculum to determine the proper modalities for courses and the appropriate mix of modalities in their programs based upon curricular content, student needs, and mission of the programs; and be it further
- Resolved: That UPS 411.104 be modified so that online offerings may be approved via a checkbox form via the Office of Academic Affairs; and be it finally
- Resolved: That copies of this resolution be distributed to CSUF faculty, staff, and administrators.
