## Resolution in Support of Studying Academic Senate Committee Restructuring

Whereas: The Academic Senate of CSU Fullerton is structured with an existing committee structure based on previous eras and may or may not reflect the current functions of the University; and

Whereas: Maintaining a healthy organizational structure necessitates periodic reexamination of organizational structure for currency and relevancy to current and future needs; and

Whereas: The current Senate structure includes 21 Standing Committees, 3 General Committees, and 9 Miscellaneous Committees/Boards which sometimes strains the faculty and administrative resources to serve on the committees; and

Whereas: The workload for the committees varies greatly including some that have very little work and some that have way too much work; be it therefore

Resolved: That the Academic Senate of CSU Fullerton create a task force over summer 2023 whose members are nominated by the Senate Executive Committee and confirmed by the Academic Senate at the first meeting of fall 2023 to study the current committee structure; and be it finally

Resolved: That the task force make recommendations to include potential committee expansion, consolidation, or reclassification as a Miscellaneous Board.
