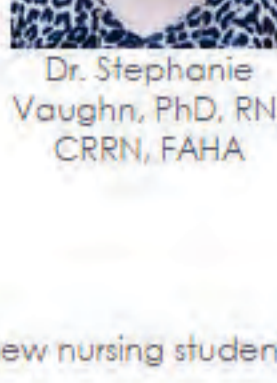




Greetings from the School of Nursing at CSU Fullerton!

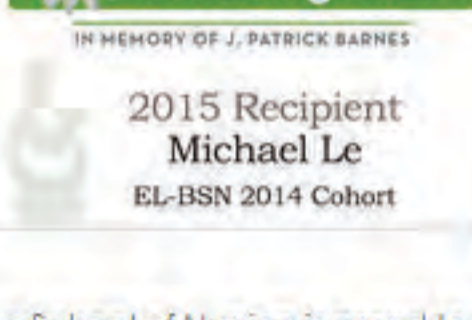
**Welcoming New Fall 2015 Students**

The School of Nursing is proud to announce our very first recipient of the DAISY In Training Award: Michael Le, EL-BSN Student.

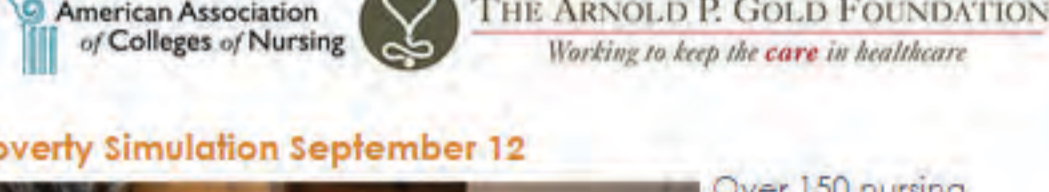

The ceremony marks the start of the clinical rotation phase of the students' nursing studies. In association with the AACN and The Arnold P. Gold Foundation, we were honored to present each student with a specially designed pin that serves as a visual reminder of their oath and commitment to providing high quality care.



**Poverty Simulation September 12**



Over 150 nursing students serve the community every semester through our Community Health Nursing classes. The rotation includes 120 hours per student placed at Departments of Public Health in Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, or San Bernardino counties as well as other community based organizations serving the homeless, under served populations, migrant families, youth at risk, youth with disabilities, etc.

For the very first time, as an introduction to the course, the School of Nursing hosted a life-like, Monopoly-style poverty simulation exercise to increase awareness about the complexities of living in day-to-day poverty and to gain a better understanding of the types of patients they will encounter throughout their career.

**Women's Health Care Program and \$125,000 Song Brown Grant**



The Women's Health Care Concentration is the first in the US to have the state-of-the-art MedaPhor ultrasound simulator ScanTrainer. The 'real feel' haptic simulators realistically replicate the transvaginal and transabdominal scanning experience with virtual patients who change shape, size and feel with each scan. The experience integrates RealEHRPrep with Cerner - an electronic health record system adapted to support full curriculum implementation.

In collaboration with the College of Health and Human Development, Dr. Ruth Mielke (Women's Health Care Concentration Lead), Dr. Asma Taha, Dr. Nik Gorman and Ms. Barb Doyer (Nursing Simulation Center Coordinator) garnered the grant funding from the OSHPD California Healthcare Workforce Policy Commission, Song Brown Registered Nurse Education Program.
