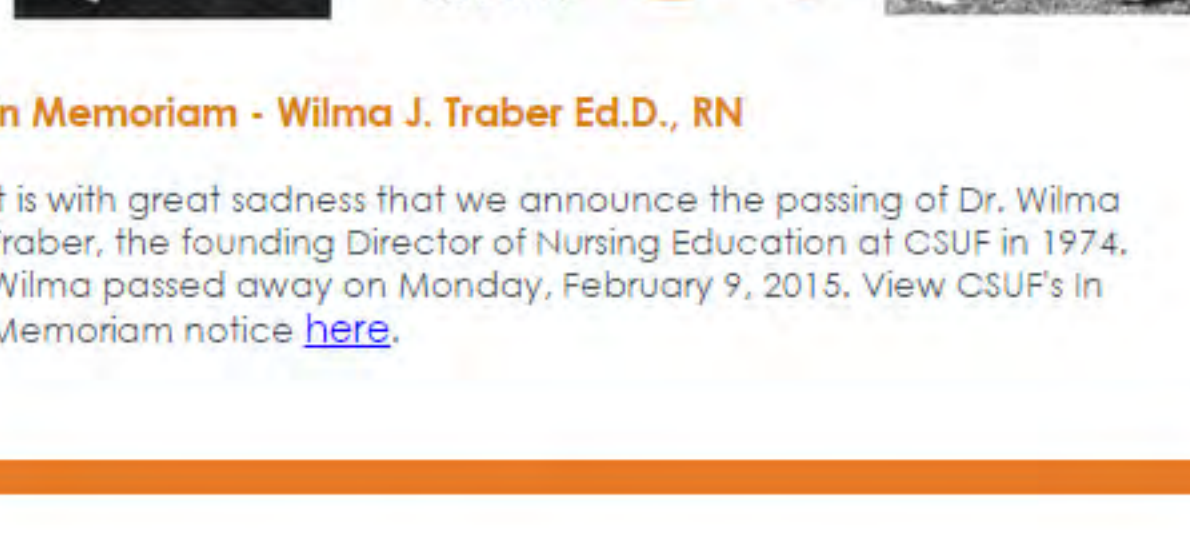


Greetings from the School of Nursing at CSU Fullerton!

In Memoriam - Wilma J. Traber Ed.D., RN

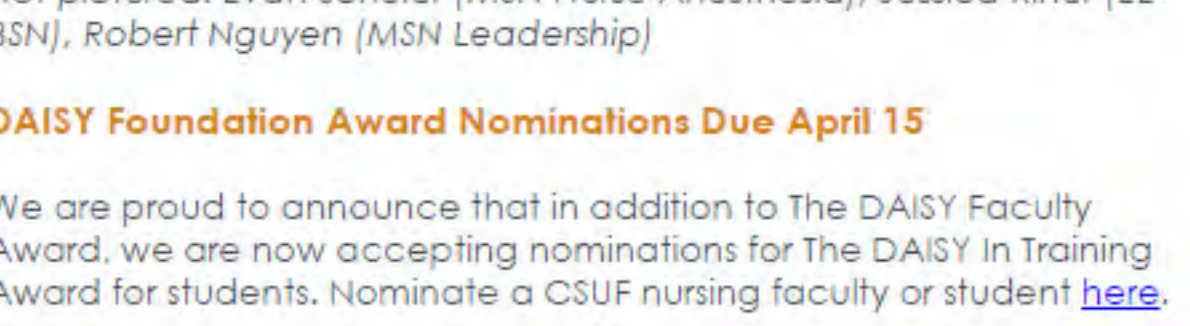

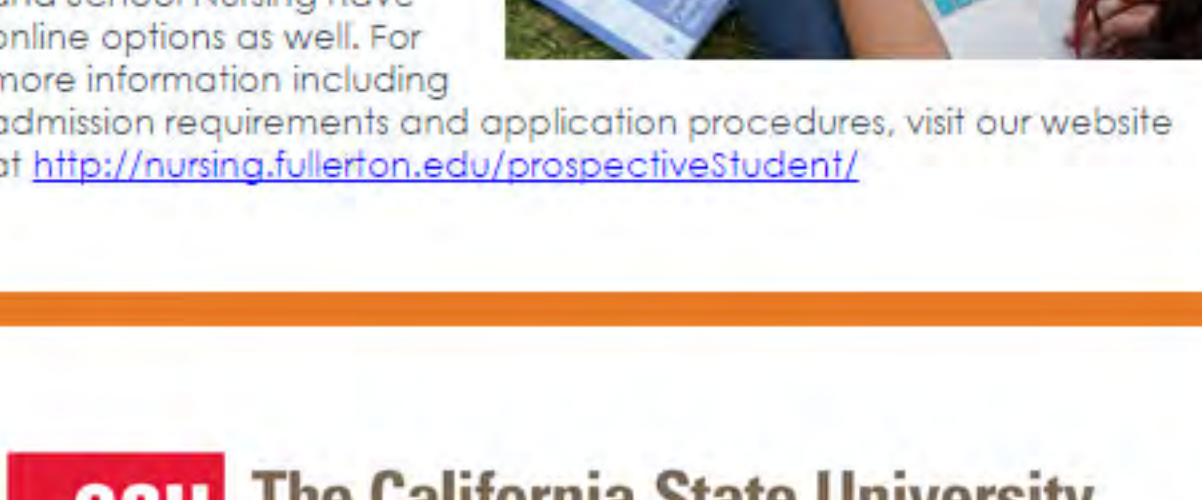
RN-BSN Program

Full-time Distance Option Starting Fall 2015

Starting in Fall 2015, the RN-BSN program at the School of Nursing will offer a full-time distance (online) option. Students will be able to complete the program in as little as three semesters (one year). Courses will be offered online with the exception of two lab courses, which will be offered at partner facilities within Orange County, Riverside County, or Los Angeles County. In addition, the part-time distance option as well as the full-time and part-time campus option will continue to be offered. The School of Nursing hopes to address the needs of working nurses by offering a flexible program to serve all learning styles.

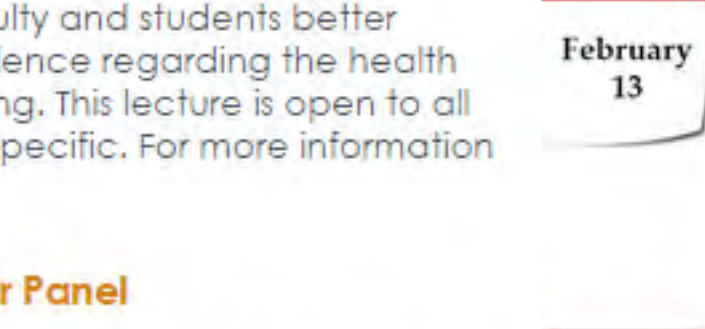

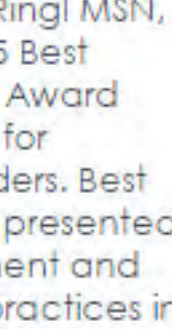
Barbara Sattler, RN, DrPH, FAAN presents Health Risks Associated with Fracking

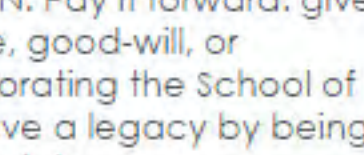
Meef Dr. Rachel McClanahan

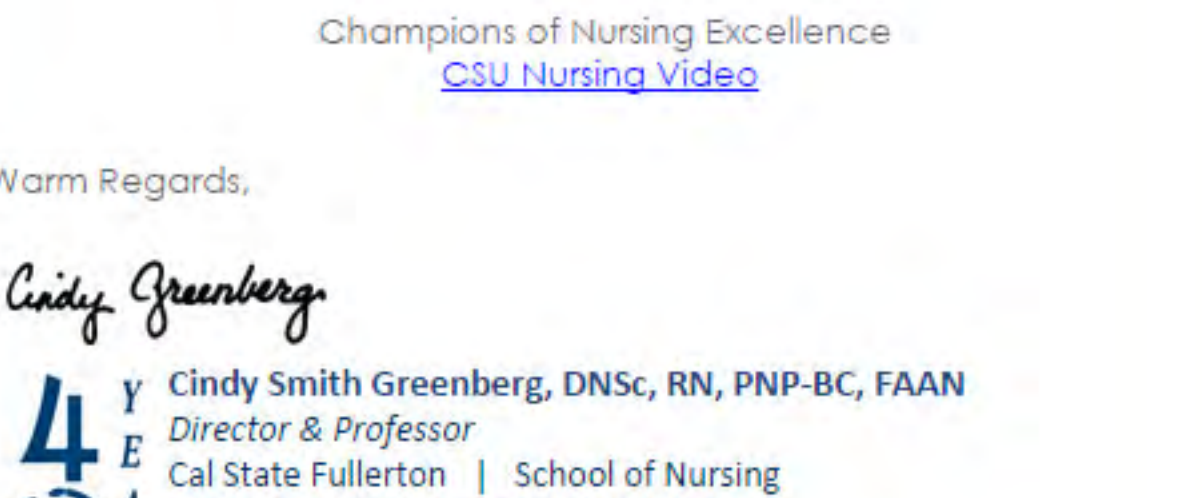
