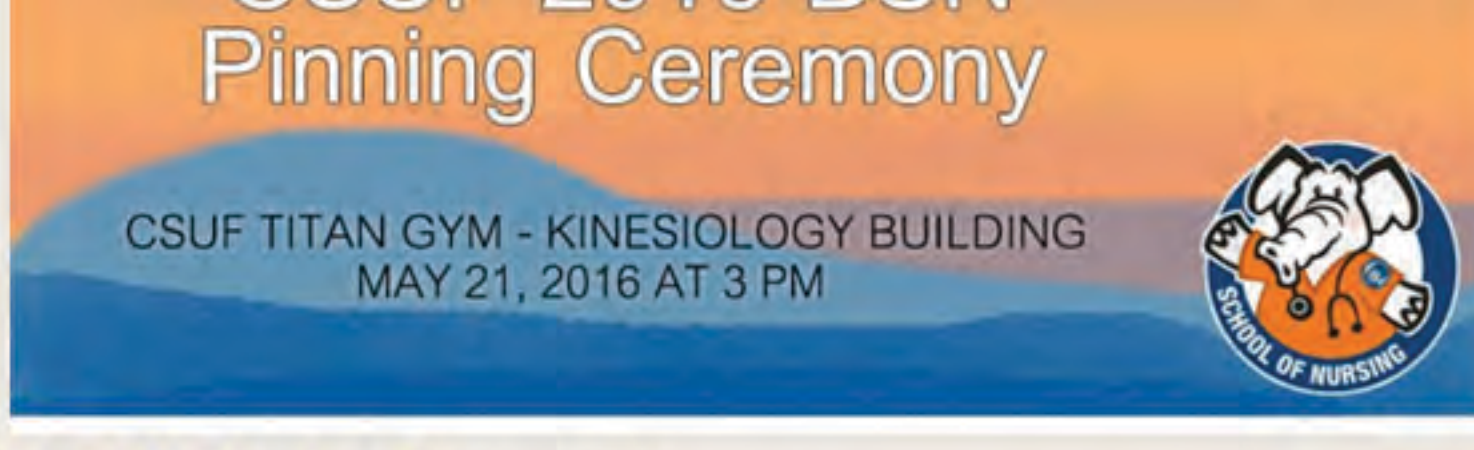


10th Anniversary "NightinGala" Awards Dinner Poster Presentation and Induction Ceremony
