FORMER REPUBLIC OF SOMALILAND FOREIGN MINISTER AND FIRST LADY VISITS TO COLLABORATE

The School of Nursing collaborated a visit from nurse midwife and women's health advocate, Dr. Edna Adan Ismail. Dr. Adan is the former Foreign Minister and former first lady of the Republic of Somaliland. Dr. Adan shared that the health of the people of Somaliland is among the worst in the world, that one in eleven children die in infancy, and nearly 4,000 women die in childbirth each year. This tragedy is largely due to the civil war which caused the death or departure of nearly all the country's health care professionals.

During her visit, Dr. Adan toured the School of Nursing Simulation Center and met a group of CSUF nursing students. Dr. Adan was particularly interested in seeing low-fidelity simulation tools such as "Mama Natalie" as they would be easiest to implement in her hospital. She also explored some of the high-fidelity simulation tools available, such as the ultrasound simulator used to train students on the use of ultrasound in obstetrics/gynecology. [Read more...](#)

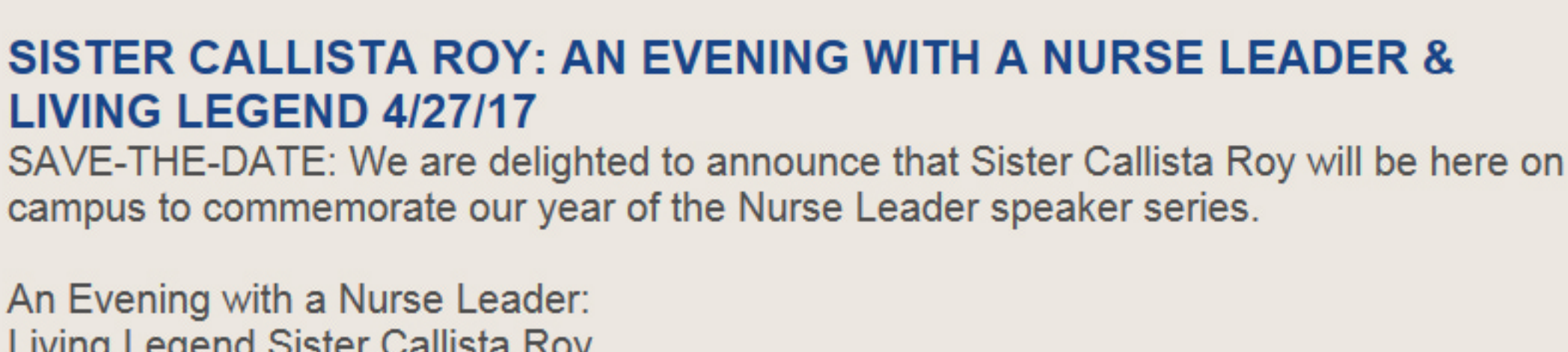

Several nursing faculty are working on research projects and need help from CSUF students.

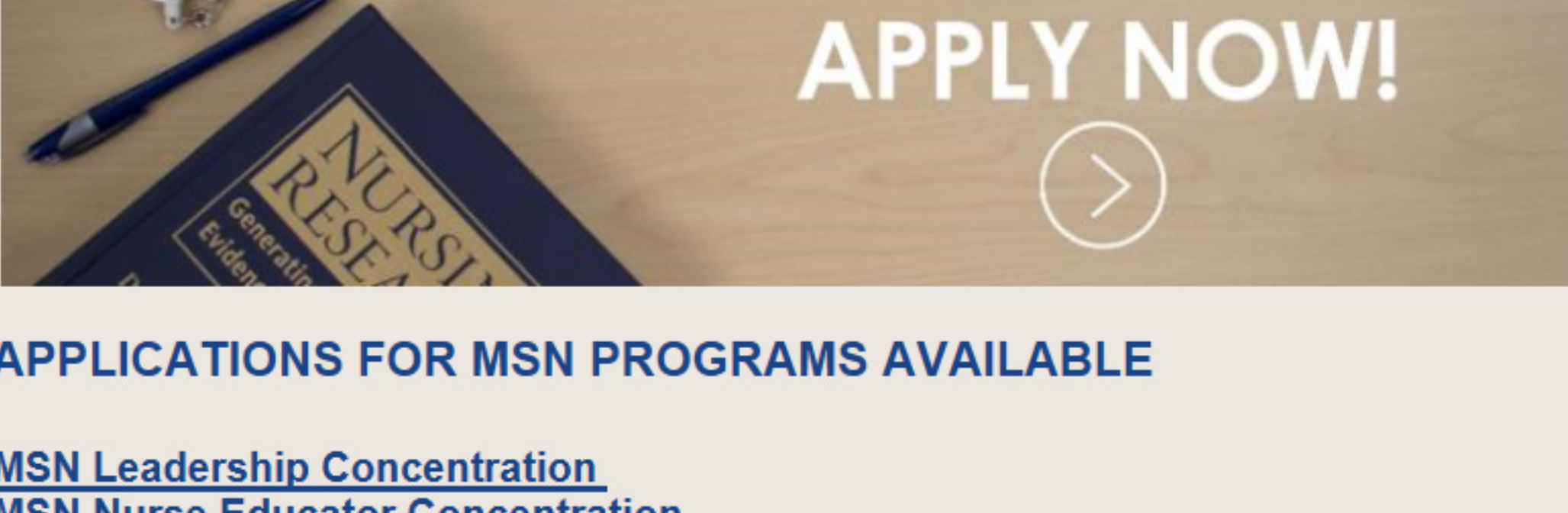
Dr. Rose Sakamoto's Robust Aging Program located at the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute has begun a study on Vitamin D supplementation and its effects on cognition for adults between 60 and 90 years of age.

With this study, the program will provide basic health assessment of older adults, provide opportunities for student education and service training related to health assessment and health promotion in older adults, promote interprofessional research in the practice setting on age related predictors for health behavior change, and collaborate with community agencies in sharing resources and providing services to meet the health promotion needs of older adults.

Study participants and student RNs are needed now through June 2018.

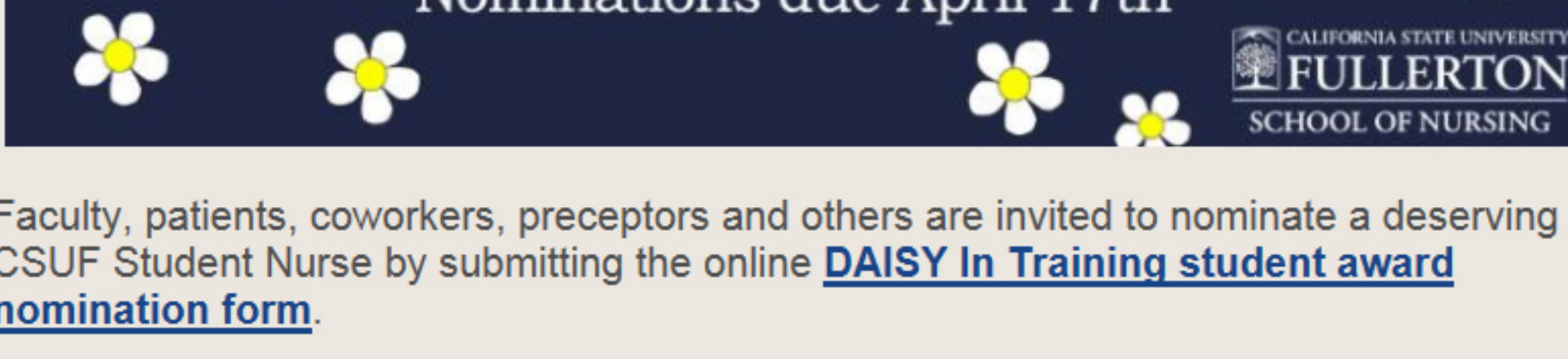
